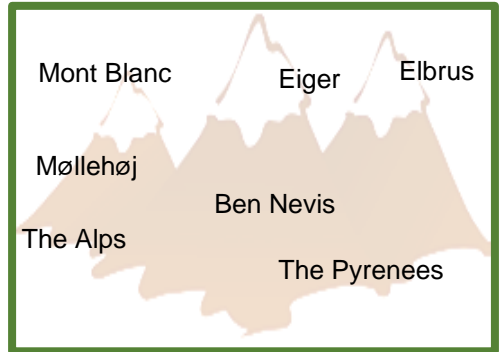
Russia
